2. Confirm that students **do not** need to be connected to a VPN to visit the site. If users are connected to a VPN, this may slow down the user experience – i.e. possible increased loading times for content.

Q: What is the URL so that my schools can whitelist it?

Q: Is the platform device-specific?

A: The Elements of STEM platform has been designed to be optimized for Google Chromebooks; however, any desktop, laptop, tablet or mobile device can join. There is a mobile version of the site that looks a little different, but still contains all the same information.

Q: What is the most common problem that prevents students from having a successful experience in this platform?

A: Slow home internet speed is the most common issue. Our first question is to confirm that the student is not connected to a VPN, which can slow things down even further.

Q: How do students log in?

A: Each school will be given a 4 digit user login code to enter the platform on the day of their event. These login codes will be valid after the live event days enabling users to access content at a later date.

Q: What personal information is being collected?

A: None. Neither JA nor our platform provider are given a list of attendees. All participants connect anonymously to the platform – the only identifier is the IP address and the school login code.

Q: Are you using Zoom?

A: Yes, students are invited to join optional live sessions via Zoom Webinar. The video and chat features will be disabled. Students may submit questions (by typing them in), but these will only be visible to the host & moderators (JA staff). Students do not need to have the Zoom app downloaded to their computers. As long as <https://zoom.us> isn't blocked, students should be able to access all the live sessions through the site.
